Franks receive Silva Award 2004

2004 SILVA AWARD WINNER ANNOUNCED

At the Annual General Meeting of the United States Orienteering Federation (USOF), held on July 2nd in Cleveland, Georgia, President Chuck Ferguson announced the winner of the 2004 Silva Award. Ferguson revealed to those in attendance that the 2004 recipients of the award are long-time orienteers Mark and Mary Frank.

The Silva Award, USOF's highest volunteer honor, is given for outstanding service to the sport of orienteering in the United States during the previous five years.

Here is the text of the letter nominating Mark & Mary Frank for the Silva Award:

We of DVOA would like to nominate Mark and Mary Frank for the Silva award. Our success as a club is largely due to their efforts. For over 20 years Mark Frank has continuously been the driving force behind the growth of DVOA and Mary has been the glue that holds the club together.

Mark first appeared on our membership list in 1979 as a recent graduate and member of the orienteering club at Indiana University of Pennsylvania. His enthusiasm for orienteering was so great that he claims his job search was limited to areas with established orienteering clubs! We are eternally grateful that he found us. A bit later he also found Mary Schaad who was working at the time in New Jersey and attending our events. They announced their engagement at our winter planning meeting in 1990, and were married later that year.

It was Mark who volunteered to be co-director of the first A event hosted by DVOA back in 1982. He shared his apartment with the field checker while the original French Creek West map was being prepared. The event set an attendance record of 750 participants that lasted for years. Mark has never missed an opportunity to mention orienteering. On our membership application is a blank asking how you first heard about orienteering. A classic response on one application was from a lady who wrote: "I sat next to Mark Frank on an airplane".

Mary willingly took over the job of secretary/treasurer of DVOA when Caroline Ringo resigned after 25 years and promised to keep it for the next 25! Two pregnancies and the births of Robert and Michelle have not kept her from giving numerous clinics at nature centers, scout events, sports stores, malls, or wherever else she was asked. Mark and Mary's friendly attitude has brought many new members to the club. Every spring, summer, fall and winter the DVOA schedule lists several beginner events hosted by the Franks; many, many more individually arranged private workshops are not on the schedule.

The Franks were the force behind the formation of the Susquehanna Valley Orienteering Club, making regular pilgrimages into that area looking for the right people to carry the DVOA philosophy into the central Pennsylvania region. They have now set a goal of establishing another Pennsylvania club in the Pittsburgh area and have made some progress in that effort.

Separately or together the Franks have directed over 100 events on our color maps, plus numerous others on black and white maps in the early years. Their list includes two US Championships,



the DVOA 30th anniversary A event, and a team trial.

In 1984 Mark helped to found, and since has coordinated, the Educational Services group within DVOA. Their job is to spread interest in Orienteering through educational programs. In the years since 2000, the DVOA Educational Services have taught more than 90 separate programs each year, in addition to teaching at regularly scheduled local events. They have done adult night school programs, corporate team building programs, scout leader training programs, programs at 4-H clubs, for home schoolers, taught at nature and environmental centers, scout camps, and REI. They have set up teacher training for schools and done high school JROTC training. It was Mark Frank that sold Ed Scott on the idea of establishing the annual Mid-Atlantic Scout Orienteering Championships, which since its inception has totaled over 10,000 participants, and has now spun off at least three additional annual scout events in the Mid Atlantic region. He still teaches and Mary does the on site registration every year for this event.

On a national level, Mark has served on the USOF board of directors. He has been in charge of Long Range Planning and Education and was Vice President in charge of Program Development. Mary has been coordinator for USOF Club Development and New Club Support, and has been director of Mid-Atlantic Regional Club Development. The strategies for growth that Mark has pioneered for DVOA have served as examples to help other clubs to grow, thus building a stronger base for USOF.

The Franks have been the driving force behind DVOA since I joined orienteering 10 years ago; I can not imagine the club succeeding at the level it does without them. They work at virtually every event, average well over one teaching assignment or educational program a week, store much of the club equipment and map supply, host our meetings, house our mappers, mail our newsletter, and do just about everything else that is essential to our continued growth.

As I look over the list of Silva winners, I see a group of people that have dedicated a portion of their lives to serving our sport. The Franks are certainly well qualified in both the length and quality of service they are giving. In recent years they have chosen to dedicate their energies to DVOA and the establishment of clubs in the Mid-Atlantic region, but have encouraged several other club members (Randy Hall, Jim Eagleton, and myself to name just a few) to be involved at the national level in their place. They truly love orienteering and miss no opportunity to spread the word.

A letter from the the Franks to USOF

Mark and Mary Frank say thanks

First we would like to mention that we are truly disappointed not to be able to orienteer in Maine this weekend. However, life dictated another path for us at the last moment.

We must say how very surprised we were to have been honored with the Silva Award. At first, when we saw a few congratulations via some ambiguous emails we actually thought it was a joke. When it showed up on the DVOA website, we knew it must be true. We spoke emotionally by phone and Mark was actually speechless. Yes you heard that right...Mark was speechless.

You see the Silva Award was a long term goal for us and we still consider ourselves much too young in our orienteering lives to receive such a prestigious award. When you look at the past list of winners we are quite humbled to be included with these individuals.

Although it is not possible to thank everyone, we would like to mention some of the individuals and families that have been inspirations and great influences on our orienteering way of life. In DVOA land we must first mention our adopted parents, Kent and Caroline Ringo, for their true love of the sport. Also, early DVOA pioneers such as the Hugh MacMullan Family, The John Edwards

The Early History of Briar Rabbit

From the June 1979 (Vol. II No. 2) issue of "Notes From the Briar Patch":

Legend has it that Brer Rabbit had a kid brother who left his home in the South to seek fortune and adventure. As he traveled 'round the country, he had many escapades as interesting as those of his more famous brother. None of these were recorded, however, since he never stayed in one place for very long, and had met no one like Uncle Remus to tell of his exploits.

Although he was happy in the adventurous life he led, he did miss one thing from his childhood days - a truly quality briar patch. In fact, after years of roaming around, he began to doubt his own memory of those impenetrable thickets, where bushes as high as a tall man's head, with thorns as big as nails, covered acres and acres of land.

One day he hopped off a freight car in the Delaware Valley, took one look around, and decided to settle down. For, in addition to all the excitement of a busy urban area, he discovered that the area abounded in truly monumental briar patches at least as impassable as those he remembered from his youth. Assunpink, Ridley Creek, Tyler, Collier's Mill, Nockamixon, French Creek and Lebanon all became a haven for him when he needed a brief escape from city life.



Eventually, he befriended the only other life that willingly chose to enter the briar patches - people who called themselves DVOA orienteers, who searched, unmindful of the briars, for small red and white markers. When he heard that they competed annually against a group that had a turtle as a mascot, he made up his mind to join them, to help them, and to be their mascot and good luck charm.

Ladies and Gentlemen of DVOA, we're happy to introduce - BRIAR RABBIT.

Notes on the above article and on later developments, by Caroline Ringo, DVOA archivist:

At the time the above article appeared, Hugh MacMullan III was editor of our newsletter, which up until this issue had been called "Compass Points". Since many of our locations were famous for their briars, Hugh borrowed freely from the Uncle Remus tales of Brer Rabbit and introduced Briar Rabbit on the masthead. He also promoted our first DVOA T-shirt, designed by his daughter Lauren. This featured a circle enclosing a hurrying Disney-style cartoon rabbit with a compass in his hand. The choice of a rabbit as our mascot was prompted by the fact that Larry Crane from Ridgewood up near the New York state border had attended our events during our early years, and along with his wife Linda had started an orienteering club in their local area. It was called the Ramapo Orienteering Club, named for the Ramapo Mountains. They had a newsletter with a cartoon turtle on a hilltop, map in hand and sweat pouring from his brow while gazing across a valley to another distant hill which had on its very top an orienteering control. It was only natural that we should have a hare to challenge their tortoise. In 1980 the Ramapo Club merged with the Westchester O club of New York State and became Hudson Valley Orienteering (HVO). No one knows what happened to the turtle.



In the March 1982 issue of the Briar Patch the current version of our club mascot made his debut, thanks to the artistic abilities of Lisa Walters from IUPOC, who later married John Overton and lived in our area for awhile. This issue also announced a Name the Rabbit contest, which was extended

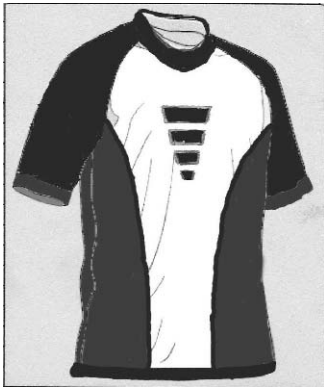

until the summer meeting. Judges narrowed the selection to five names and a vote was taken. O'HARE was the name chosen. Since the name had been submitted by both Sue Edwards and Ginger Burd, each received a stuffed rabbit very much in the image of O'Hare. Ginger later found an almost life-size plush rabbit and made a DVOA suit for him.

In the fall of 1993 the Byar family and Marie Reynolds made a papier mache head and furry paws and tail, allowing us to have a life-size mascot. Max Byer donned the outfit for O'Hare's first outing on December 10, 1993 when he gave out candy canes at Nottingham. O'Hare has made several other appearances, including taking tickets at our Saturday night A-meet dinner in June 1995 and giving out Easter candy at the April 11, 1998, meet at Mount Joy. Addison Cole and Steve Reeps have also been past portrayers of O'Hare. Keep watching -- who knows where he will turn up next?

Or what he will look like when he does...

A couple of members are currently researching alternatives for new DVOA uniforms. The intent is to get away from the "pajama" look and have something available to members that is more current and pleasing to the eye. An online discussion on the eBoard about this a few months ago sparked quite a bit of interest. We'll have something to look at and discuss at the winter meeting. Some samples...

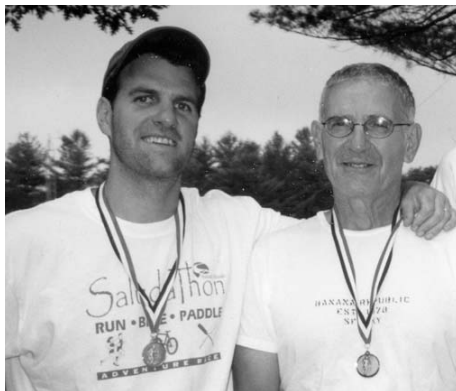
USOF convention report

Ten days of rain is enough to dampen anyone's spirit, unless it brings cool temperatures and stops long enough to orienteer nine days in the South. Such was the case at the 2004 USOF Convention hosted by GAOC and COK in the beautiful Blue Ridge Mountains of Western Carolina and North Georgia. The event was billed as GRITS; the acronym stood for Gold Rush In The South. We learned that gold was first discovered, not in California, but in Georgia. Several of the courses went over ground disturbed and sculpted by past mining activity. No, we didn't discover any gold, but we had a marvelous time.

The Carolina Orienteering Klub (COK) kicked off the event with its two-day Blue Ridge Challenge A-Meet on a new and challenging map at DuPont State Forest, N.C., near Hendersonville. More than 70 competitors were treated to early morning temperatures of 65 degrees - ideal for fast runs through the woods. About half of the competitors stayed over on Monday to try the Mountain Bike-O at the same park before enjoying a leisurely car-O on their way to the convention site in Cleveland, GA.

(Caroline's note: Most exciting to us was seeing Stan Knight and son Dave again. Stan did a lot to make our Assumpink map a reality and set a permanent course there years ago. Dave was on the US junior team, went on to medical school and is now a doctor of interventional radiation in Columbia, S.C. Stan recently moved to Isle of Palms, S.C. They both won awards both weekends and also participated in the Bike-O. On the second weekend of A meets, they were joined by former DVOA members Bob and Janet Putnam. Bob is a past president of DVOA and now a guiding force in the Florida Orienteering Club, so it was a real reunion for those of us from DVOA.)

Once people arrived at the convention site, they had the choice to sit back and enjoy a restful vacation or they could fill almost every single minute with orienteering workshops, fun-o events and orienteering competitions. The location was a small Baptist college, and we all stayed in the same dorm, which featured a big front porch with rocking chairs where you could sit and gaze out at the mountains or rest up after the steep hillside climb to the dining hall. There was a large lounge where everyone congregated, and the showers had plenty of hot water. The campus was partly wooded -- ideal for the workshops and fun-O events.

Many attendees opted for a special clinic that focused on a single aspect of orienteering for the entire week. Eighteen people attended the Mapping Clinic, led by J-J Cote with the assistance of Sam Smith. They learned how to prepare a base map, the finer points of field checking and OCAD basics. Five juniors attended the Junior Training Camp, led by Bob and Josephine Turbyfill. They learned the basic principles of orienteering and practiced course study, pacing and other o-exercises. Several kids attended the KIDS Camp, led by Pam, Nancy, and Emily Ferguson. These kids had a crash course in crafts and later put on a fashion show to display their tie-dyed t-shirts, painted bird houses, mugs, picture frames and more. So many orienteering workshops were sandwiched in between orienteering events and fun-o that many people complained because they couldn't attend everything. Among the most popular workshops were the Geology Grab Bag, Geocaching and

Letterboxing, and promotional clinics. *(Laurie Searle asked me to help her lead a workshop on club websites and newsletters. We had a display of club newsletters, and I gave out a lot of back issues of the Briar Patch -- a real attention-getter! Laurie praised DVOA for having one of the best websites and showed examples from several clubs.)*

Robin and Steve Shannonhouse kept everyone entertained with their Fun-O events, which included Poker-O and Un-Extreme-O, while Walter Siegenthaler led a late-night vampire-O with red flashlights and punch card exchanges. The U.S. Trail-O Champs offered fierce competition this year, but Bob Turbyfill took home the gold and a chance to represent the U.S. in the upcoming international competition. *(There are two classes in Trail-O: for those with problems which prevent them from doing a regular course and exactly the same course for the rest of us to try. It's all done from wheelchair accessible trails, and you choose which of several controls is hung at the spot marked on your map. And it ain't easy! I think I had about 3 or 4 out of 10 correct.)*

The Bubba Goat was set by Sam Smith on one of the most technical maps our competitors had ever run on. Competitors had the option of following others and could skip up to two controls for the traditional long course or up to 7 controls for the shorter option. Winner J-J. Cote had an outstanding run as the long-course winner at 135 minutes. The Georgia Orienteering Club hosted its first Park-O, thanks to Kevin Haywood, who took advantage of a USOF grant to make a new Park-O map of the Truett-McConnell College. GAOC also trialed e-punching, thanks to Valerie Meyer, who lent her expertise in setting up the e-punches and programs.

Evening entertainment included local musicians and storytellers, but the best show was the O-Show starring many of the convention participants, including a skit and song by the Junior Team, the KIDS Camp fashion show, and jokes, stories, tall tales and songs by willing participants.

The highlight of the annual general meeting on Friday was announcement of the recipients of the coveted Silva award, given annually to someone who has contributed much to the growth of orienteering in the US. This year, Mark and Mary Frank of DVOA were honored. (See separate article in this issue.)

GAOC closed out the week with its two-day GA Navigator Cup A-Meet at Smithgall Woods. With early morning starts at 8am to take advantage of the cool temperatures, most competitors finished well before noon. The first day was extremely challenging, but many competitors reported a better time the second day once they had a chance to learn the terrain. Relocation is finding your way when you are lost

New and experienced orienteers get lost at nearly every event they go to. They do not always know exactly where they are all the time and frequently cannot find control points because they do not plan their routes carefully, run too fast, get disoriented, and lose their place on the map. This is part of the challenge of the sport—the balance of using our O skills and pacing yourself with the certainty of knowing where you are. How fast can you run while reading the map and also find controls? Which route to take and be assured of staying on course? These answers come with time and practice.

It is easy to get lost, panic and run around in circles, wasting even more time. It is a common occurrence with all orienteers. To minimize the effects on your performance and mental attitude towards the sport, it's important to develop a strategy for relocation.

A common mistake of beginners is to think you haven't gone far enough. The control is just over the next hill or around the curve ahead. Keep going, even though you don't have any idea where you're at, and somehow you will miraculously find your way. This usually results in more confusion and getting even farther off course.

As soon as you are not certain where you are, SLOW DOWN and try to pick up features you see on the map. If you still lost, DO NOT PANIC! Try to stay cool and think calmly. Do not keep wandering about. Stop where there are at least two distinctive features that you would expect to see on the map. Orient the map to north, and try to match the pattern of features with those on the map. With the features you see, you can really only be in one place.

If you still cannot place yourself, think carefully and recall the features you followed from the last control or your last known position. Could you have left the control 180 degrees in the wrong direction? If after only one or two minutes you are still lost, you should make your way to a major line feature. Find out exactly where you are on the map and then continue navigating to the control. If at this stage you are worried or not enjoying the experience for any reason, then you can make your way to the finish! Ask someone the way back if necessary.

(Editor's note: Always remember to check in at finish, whether or not you complete the course, so that the event organizers will know you are safely out of the woods.)

Tatum Park Scout O

*Editor's Note: The following write-up about the Tatum Park Scout-O was inadvertently omitted from the June 2004 issue of the **Briar Patch**; the results were included in that issue.*

Thanks to all the DVOA members/friends for helping me and 160 or so Scouts at the Tatum Park O event (Middletown, NJ) on this warm (77 degrees F and sunny), May 15, especially DVOA members Kent and Carolyn Ringo, Jerry Smith, Jerry's Troop 70 Scout friend Gregory, Mr. and Mrs. Theo Zaharia and Kathleen Geist. Thanks also to HVO members Jeff; his dad, Mike Kurtz; and Jeff's two sisters. There were also many Scout walk-on volunteers, especially Tr. 246 Scout Brian Bosch, who assisted with the O flag set out with Jeff, and Scouters Tr. 32 Diane and Charles Messina, who helped check in units at the registration table and who handed out Scout event Patches (with Mike Kurtz) to the participants (red Scout patch version). Special kudos to Jerry Smith, handling all the O training requests, and honorable mention to HVO's Paul Bennett, who took all my scribbled Tatum winter field notes and completed the OCAD of this brand new topo map in March. While it is unusual to complete a new map right before the event (I saw that as a low risk effort), in this case we had plenty of time leeway and tons of fun when hiking/vetting the O courses. It is a credit to Jeff that he was able set courses with a map draft that was 70 percent complete. Tatum is an under-used but well-developed, sleepy county park; joggers, bikes and a few dog walkers are the norm on the trails and open fields.

This was the debut of this HVO/Rycharski team Tatum topo map (although a Beta topo map was used in 2001), and the park rangers and Scouts alike were thrilled at the long overdue completion of this forest/park map. All hiked quite safely on White through Green courses, but there was a mishap on the Yellow short course, a sprained ankle by a GS unit leader, but I am proud to say the Scouts made and implemented a rescue plan on their own, hiked a quarter mile back to a house they had noticed on the park edge, asked permission to call for an ambulance, and arranged for a team sportsmen's-like withdrawal and a trip to Riverside Hospital with other leaders to check on their hurt but recovering leader. Packs 331 (White), Troops 71 (Yel. short), 180 (Yel Long) and 252 (OJ) were overall Scout winners on this timed Scout course. Any adults on the course: please remember the awards are for the young Scouts, some of which had the "Aha!, I can map read and orienteer!" light click on at this event. Every now and then a comment was made that the courses were age appropriate but did make the Scout teams think a bit at certain trail junctions. We had two control markers with switched three-digit codes, which confused some hikers on the Yellow course, but they were at the proper mapped feature, and understanding leaders said it should have taught the Scouts to expect the unexpected sometimes when hiking and orienteering.

Scouts were very happy with the courses designed by second-class (Troop 1, Garden City, Long Island) Scout Jeff Kurtz-and with the unannounced Oreos and other cookies and cool ice water that greeted the trekkers at the map hike finish line. Many Scouts were interested in the DVOA 2004 summer schedule that I passed out, and they couldn't wait until the next October NJ Scout map-hike event as the Tatum Park (some volunteered to help)! This meet was a good first-time experience for all (80 percent of attending units were new to the event), so I think more than a few NJ Scout units will be traveling to nearby DVOA O events in the next few months.

Today's Word: Invious (Adjective)

Pronunciation: ['in-vi-ês]

Definition: Impassable, inaccessible, without paths or roads.

Usage: Do not confuse today's word with "envious" ['en-vi-ês] from "envy."

Be sure you write things like: "People will be envious (not invious!) of your talent!"

Suggested Usage: Close to earth, the word may refer to areas inaccessible by road: "My friends and I love hiking the invious areas of the Colorado Rockies." On an even higher plane than the Rockies: "I would say his mind is less enviabable than invious-almost impenetrable."

Etymology: Latin in- "not" + via "way, road" from Proto-Indo-European (PIE) *wegh-, which also gave Sanskrit vah-âmi "bring, lead," German Weg "way" and Wagen "wagon," and English "way" and "wagon." From the same root we get Latin vehiculum "carriage," derived from veh-ere "bear, carry," and borrowed into English as "vehicle."

Building Your Orienteering Word Power

Attack point - a feature that you can readily identify and locate to go to the last hundred meters or so to the control feature

Contour (noun) - a brown line on the map indicating a constant elevation; collectively, contour lines show the shape of the terrain. Also, an imaginary line of constant elevation in the terrain; the shape of the terrain.

Handrail - a linear feature that can be followed between controls, simplifying navigation and map reading

Key - the list of symbols represented on a map and their meanings; also, the "legend."

Orienting the map - turning the map until it is lined up with the terrain, either using linear terrain features or the compass

Route choice - one of two or more ways to get from one control to the next

Safety bearing - direction to head when in trouble that will lead you back to the start or a sure route to the start, such as a hard-surface road

Scale - the relationship of distance between the ground and map, usually 1:15,000 (1 cm = 150 m) or 1:10,000 (1 cm = 100 m)

Sometime in the latter half of October it occurred to me that I had volunteered to set courses for Iron Hill in early December. I also knew that after Brian May's success at WOC, the Sprint was an orienteering discipline with some newfound interest. So I thought about maybe having a sprint course at Iron Hill and with some encouragement from various quarters, finally decided to go ahead and just do it. I got some help from the US Team: Brian May gave me some feedback on the course design and Peter Gagarin publicized the event in a few venues. DVOA agreed to run the sprint part of the event as a fundraiser for the Venture Crew to help defray the costs of traveling to Texas in the spring to try to repeat their success at last year's Interscholastic Championships in return for members of the Venture Crew helping out at the event.

To encourage maximum participation and maximum spectating, the Sprint was scheduled to go off at 10am. Things were a little chaotic at registration, and we couldn't generate the start list fast enough so the Sprint didn't start until 10:10 but there was a good crowd watching the start and quite a few people wandered down to watch them finish 10 or 15 minutes later. The almost 30 competitors started at 30-second intervals, and so the last few people were starting just as the first few people were finishing.

The winner, in 11:25, was Leif Anderson, a rising star in US orienteering. Leif is a member of SAMM, an orienteering club in the state of Washington where he is from; he is currently attending college in New England and just happened to be in the area and made plans to attend the event. Second was Alexi Azarov from HVO and third Clem McGrath from DVOA. There were a couple of major and several minor route choice decisions to be made, but mostly the key was to run flat out for the entire 1.95 km.

Although most everything went well, there were a couple of minor glitches. The start triangle on the map and the actual start were not at the same place (my fault for not being careful) and the difference, while only 15 feet or so, was significant. Also, the flag at the first control fell to the ground a few minutes into the race, but luckily Eric Weyman was nearby watching the runners, noticed the flag was no longer visible and quickly got to the site and retied the flag on the tree so that only one or two competitors were affected.

A lot of people helped to make the event successful. Most notably, Nancy Sharp handled all things e-punch related and having the epunch and being able to compare splits was a big part of the fun of the event. (And after the Sprint was done she stayed put and worked another couple hours at the computer for the regular courses!) Charlie Robinson helped me get the names in the right order for the start; Eric Weyman, Ralph Tolbert, John Swaren, Maryann Cassidy, Denny Porter, Mark Cornish and the Venture Crew all helped with control hanging and pickup, setting up the finish, pre-running the Sprint to make sure all the epunches were in active mode and just generally pitching in to get everything ready.

Regular courses were also available with epunching on the three advanced courses, brown, green and red. With the flat terrain, mostly open woods and courses on the shorter side, winning times on these courses were fast as well.

Janet and Denny Porter were the event directors, and they were kept busy all day. Two large scout troops showed up early and almost all the Sprint runners stuck around and ran a regular course after the Sprint. And so despite what I thought would be way too many pre-printed maps, they were hand drawing extra maps within the first hour. Registration was so busy, they ran out of pink cards! And there was a brisk business at the soup pot - thanks to Janet for providing delicious

turkey soup to all the volunteers.

And thanks to all those volunteers: - in addition to those who helped with the Sprint many of whom also helped all day. I remember Tom Overbaugh, Jim Eagleton and Wyatt Riley working start and finish, and Mark and Mary Frank at registration but I'm sure there were lots of others. A great way to finish off the 2004 O season!
