

Final Course Notes

Trail O Fox Chaser II

Ridley Mansion

First starts are at 11am. You are welcome to come before your assigned start time but assigned start times will be given priority. Parking for the event is at the Ridley Mansion/Park Office. Please park in the spaces furthest from the mansion so our event has minimal impact on other park visitors. Depending on the weather we may be sharing the trails around the mansion with a large number of park visitors. You will see the Trail O registration tent as you drive into the parking lot. Please come there to receive your punch card, the map for the model event and instructions for where to start the course. There are nearby handicapped parking spaces and restrooms.

The map is ISSOM with a scale of 1:4000 and contour intervals of 2.5 meters. The course length is 1.0 kilometer with 25 meters of climb. There are 3 timed controls and 17 standard Trail O stations with a time limit of 84 minutes for competitors in the open category and 90 minutes for paralympic competitors. The map is predominantly “urban” with a large number of manmade features. The course is paved and is mapped as a road per ISSOM. There will be pink ribbon in the terrain with notations on the map to indicate forbidden access at 3 locations. An open black circle on the map represents a park bench or picnic table and a green X indicates a root stock.

Tyler Arboretum

First starts are at 10am. You are welcome to come before your assigned start time but assigned start times will be given priority. Parking for the event is at the main parking area for Tyler Arboretum. The Trail O registration tent is near the start of the Foot Orienteering courses. Follow the signs that will be posted. Restrooms are located in the barn which is on the way to the start. There will not be a model event.

The map is ISSOM with a scale of 1:4000 and contour intervals of 2.5 meters. The course length is 1.2 kilometer with 15 meters of climb. There are 3 timed controls and 16 standard Trail O stations with a time limit of 84 minutes. The course is paved and is mapped as a road per ISSOM. For control #9 there is a short path to the viewing station which is on a flat cinder path. There will be pink ribbon in the terrain with notations on the map to indicate forbidden access at 3 locations. An open black circle on the map represents a park bench and a green X indicates a root stock
