#### • Equipment Report - Ron Bortz

We bought 2 new canopies this past year and replaced the old canopies. We purchased 2 Orienteering Blades. Ron said he purchased a Start, Finish Blades and spandex table covers. We are going to get some finger sticks that are wearing out. Ron suggests we look at some new SI Boxes. He will look at the costs so the executive committee can review. He said they were \$131 per box and we need 60 boxes. Sandy mentioned we should get some more SI Air cards to rent out. Tim wanted to know if there was a group coordinating getting personal SI Air batteries replaced. Mary asked Sandy if she needed a radio control, she said unless you have someone with software and more than 10 controls, no.

#### Mapping Update - Wyatt Riley

Petr Hartman has done at least a dozen basemaps. Some are training maps and regular maps. Professional mappers, Jon Campbell updated half of the Fair Hill map for last fall. With Eric Weyman's assistance. Bob Burg completed half of Fort Washington and getting started on 2<sup>nd</sup> half this year. Vladimir is working on the US Champs maps Merli Sarnoski and updated the

Green Lane map. He's back finishing up an addition to Merli and the sprint map for the US Champs.
